Electives: (1 month)

Elective rotations are decided by the resident. The curriculum for each elective experience must be approved by the program director and developed in consultation with a member of the faculty who will ensure orientation, supervision, teaching, and timely feedback and evaluation. These elective experiences should be driven by each resident's individualized education plan and address needs of future practice goals. The elective experiences should be developed with the guidance of a faculty mentor. These experiences should be evaluated through a structured approach by faculty members or other appropriate supervisors using multiple assessment methods, in different settings, and have systems for tracking and monitoring progress toward completing the individualized learning plan.

Vacation:

All residents receive 22 days of paid time off (20 vacation, 2 wellness days) per academic year which can be taken in the following months with program director approval.
