

Important Eligibility Information – Please Read Carefully

- 1. **Visa** If you require a visa for training purposes, the Residency/Fellowship accepts J-1, H-1B, F-1/OPT Work Authorization visas.
- 2. **Health Screening** A health screening shall include, at a minimum: basic demographic information, drug screen, latex sensitivity questionnaire, color vision screen, screening for infectious disease immunity, and any other medical testing required by regulatory agencies.
- 3. **Flu Vaccine Policy** All residents and fellows at HFH are required to receive an annual flu vaccination. This requirement may be waived with documentation of an acceptable medical or religious reason.
- 4. **COVID-19 Vaccine Policy** As we are no longer in an active health emergency, the COVID-19 vaccine is not mandatory for all residents and fellows at HFH. However, as COVID cases are up in Michigan and there are new Omicron variants, the updated vaccine is recommended.
- 5. **ECFMG** International Medical Graduates must obtain ECFMG certification in a timely manner to ensure that you can be licensed by the state of Michigan and obtain an appropriate visa (if necessary).
- 6. **NRMP** You must be eligible to participate in the NRMP match, if applicable without previous match violations.
- 7. **Orientation** You must be eligible to attend new House Officer Orientation on July 1, 2026.
- 8. **Certification** You must obtain and maintain current BLS and ACLS certification through the American Heart Association. HFH offers these courses prior to orientation at no charge.
- 9. **Licensure** You must be licensed to practice medicine by the State of Michigan throughout your residency or fellowship with HFH.
- 10. **Online Modules** You must complete all orientation modules assigned through HFH University by the assigned deadline.
- 11. **Background Check** You must have cleared the HFH background check (including criminal background check) prior to starting.
- 12. **USMLE** You must provide documentation of passing USMLE Step 1 and USMLE Step 2 or COMLEX Level 1 and COMLEX Level 2 prior to starting the program.
