## Prerequisites for Admission

1. Be a U.S. or Canadian citizen or permanent resident of the United States
2. Have a valid U.S. or Canadian Driver's License
3. Reliable vehicle upon matriculation
4. Have completed at least a four-year high school education or equivalent
5. Have completed all premedical requirements, including a bachelor's degree earned in the U.S. or Canada
6. Have taken the Comprehensive Basic Science Exam (CBSE). Scores from January 2021-present will be accepted
7. Have taken the either the [Casper Test](#) or the [AAMC PREview™](#) Professional Readiness Exam
