Each House Officer is assigned a home base clinic site where they will build their patient panel. The two clinic sites our House Officers practice at are Harbortown and Detroit Northwest. Both clinics are located in Detroit. When the House Officer is not assigned to be in clinic they will be attending their assigned monthly rotation.	HO-2/3's are assigned patients at the Boulevard Temple nursing home. They must attend and visit their patients every second Wednesday of the month for successful completion of the program.	There are a total of 5 OSCE's that must be completed before successful completion of residency. During the HO-1 year, four of the five OSCE's (Teamwork, Informed Consent, Error Disclosure, Sharing Bad News) will be completed, and the fifth OSCE (Disparity) will be completed during the HO-2 year.	Didactics are held every Wednesday afternoon. Various presenters will present a variety of lecture topics. Didactics includes clinical content, practice management, journal club, Morbidity/Mortality, and board review. Faculty and House Officers both attend didactics.	Morning Report is a junior resident inpatient case presentation for the residency and faculty. Behavior Rounds facilitate inpatient team patient interactions, wellness, interdisciplinary communication and case discussion.
