We recognize how important you are to your baby's health. Your participation in this study can help us learn what paternal factors in early life play a role in the development of food allergies and eczema (persistent itchy, dry skin). Food allergies are increasing, and this study is designed to learn how to prevent allergic conditions in children. This research could help your family and other families worldwide.

You may qualify if you:

- Are 18 years or older.
- Are planning to have your baby delivered at any one of our Henry Ford hospitals.

How long does the study last?

- You remain a part of the SUNBEAM family until your child is 3 years old.

Your participation involves:

- Filling out questionnaires on your medical history. Your medical history can provide clues on what's happening with your baby's health.
- Providing a blood sample. Your blood provides a complete picture of immune factors that may be related to your baby's health.
- One study visit.
