### YOU'RE PART OF A GROUNDBREAKING NATIONAL STUDY

We want our families to know they are part of something big. The SUNBEAM study is a national effort to enroll at least 2,500 mothers, fathers and their infants. The goal is to use major, new technological advances to discover how clinical, environmental, biological and genetic factors play roles in the development of allergic diseases. Currently, doctors have no way to identify infants who may develop eczema or food allergy and would benefit from prevention strategies. This study could lead to discoveries that will help children worldwide.

## MEET THE SUNBEAM FAMILIES

Being part of the SUNBEAM study means you are part of a group of parents living in southeast Michigan whose children are enrolled in the study. Like you, they value making contributions to important research.

#### As of November 2023:

- 80 children are active participants in the study; 49 are boys and 31 are girls.
- The average age of children in the Henry Ford Health group is nine months old, but ages range from newborn to 28 months.
- August and September are the most common birthday months, with 24 children celebrating their birthdays during the two months.
- November is the least common birthday month, with just one family celebrating their child's birthday.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

My child is already enrolled in the study and I'm expecting another baby.

Can I enroll again with my new baby? Only one child per family can enroll in the SUNBEAM study.

**Can my baby's father participate?** Yes! Fathers play an important role in the study. Input and information from both parents makes our study richer. When possible, we would love to have both parents take part and help us learn more about childhood allergy predictors.

Why don't we need to have a history of allergies in our family to be part of the study? Our goal is to recruit children with varying risk for developing allergic diseases. By doing this, we will potentially be able to identify new and additional risk factors that lead to allergies. If we enrolled only children who were at risk, it would prevent us from understanding and identifying those risk factors.

What is an "oral food challenge?" As SUNBEAM participants, infants with suspected food allergies receive no-cost food allergy testing by Henry Ford Health's Allergy & Immunology specialists. An oral food challenge is an expensive test doctors use to find out if a child is allergic to a specific food. In an oral food challenge, the child is given small amounts of the food and carefully watched by doctors and nurses for signs of an allergic reaction. It is very safe to do under close medical supervision. (You should never try to do an oral food challenge at home.) The results help you understand your child's risk of an allergic reaction, what a reaction looks like and how to treat it immediately. In the future, a food challenge can be repeated to find out if your child has outgrown the allergy and if the food can be safely added back to their diet. If the SUNBEAM team recommends an oral food challenge for your child, we will provide more details and answers to your questions. ## **KEY REMINDERS FOR SUNBEAM STUDY FAMILIES**

The SUNBEAM study has a unique schedule based on when parents enrolled. This means you will complete study activities on your own timeline, which may be different from anyone else's schedule. A few key reminders:

- Surveys are monthly and delivered to the email address you provided for the study. Please be sure to complete them every month. These are an important part of our study.
- Clinic visits are based on your child's age:
  - Visit 1: Two months old
  - Visit 2: Five months old
  - Visit 3: 12 months old
  - Visit 4: 24 months old
  - Visit 5: 36 months old

Additional clinic visits will be announced as the study continues. The research team will contact you to schedule your clinic visits and send reminders. Watch for our emails, texts and calls a few weeks before your visit is due. If you need to reschedule a clinic visit, please contact us as soon as possible and we will set up a new date for you.
