In-person *All of Us* enrollment paused until June 1

The safety and wellness of our participants are our top priorities as we are continuing to monitor the COVID-19 situation. As such, we're pausing all in-person *All of Us* appointments and events until June 1.

This pause impacts the following activities:

- In-person clinic appointments to provide physical measures and donation of biosamples (blood, urine, and/or saliva)
- Community engagement events and Pop-Up clinics

We will continually assess and make decisions about whether this pause will extend and when sites can begin preparations to re-start.

We are excited to announce the program is getting ready to start analyzing participants' DNA!

You will have the option to get personalized reports back about your ancestry, traits, if you are at risk of developing certain diseases, or how your body might react to certain medications.

At that time there will be an updated consent for you to review and complete in order to receive your results.
