




SCHEDULE YOUR SCREENING

NEW OFFICE PROTOCOLS KEEP EVERYONE SAFE

ach Henry Ford OptimEyes location has instituted new safety protocols to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of our patients and staff.

Before reopening our offices last summer, we reviewed our procedures throughout the entire patient experience, from when you first walk through the door to when you leave," says Curtis Wee, O.D., Director of Optometry. With our new safety measures, patients can come into the office and experience the same great care knowing they are safe."

Masks are mandatory for all visitors and staff, and we have instituted capacity limits at each location. When you arrive at your local office, you will get a health screen and temperature check. Inside the office, you will notice furniture is rearranged to ensure proper social distancing. Arrows on the floor help direct traffic through the office, and each examination room is rigorously cleaned between patients. On the floor, our opticians will help you select frames, disinfecting each in front of you before and after you try them on.

Our new protocols have been assessed by the Henry Ford Infection Prevention and Control Team, and I'm proud to say we've had more than 131,000 patient encounters since reopening our offices," says Dr. Wee. "As part of a health system with rigorous standards, our patients know they can trust us with their health and safety."
