Dispose of unwanted medicines by bringing them to a Henry Ford pharmacy near you or at other locations in your community. Secure bins are provided in the locations found here:

What is accepted: Prescriptions, prescription ointments, pet medications, prescription patches, over-the-counter medicine and vitamins.

What is not accepted: Needles, inhalers, aerosol cans, thermometers, lotions and liquids.
