Recipes Search Functionality

Page URL: /sitecore/content/Henry Ford/Recipes

Search:

Field Name	Field
Recipe	Enter keyword(s). Search Headline, Introduction, Content Copy
Category	Drop down, only displays categories associated to a recipe
Ingredient	Drop down, only displays ingredients associated to a recipe
Search	Begin search goes to recipe search result page filtered by matching results. Default search behavior for all modules is an AND between fields. Search with empty filters returns all results in alpha sort.

Featured Recipe:

Featured Recipe – Drop down allows you to select the recipe to display from /sitecore/content/Shared Pages/Henry Ford/Recipes only choice is recipe detail items

- Displays recipe detail image scaled to this max width and recipe detail logo overlays on image, if applicable. Ex. Heart Smart logo in design.
- Featured Recipe header label can be modified on /sitecore/content/Global/Labels/Henry Ford/Modules/Recipes/Featured Recipe Slider Labels field Featured Recipe Label



Recipes Results Functionality

Page URL: /sitecore/content/Shared Pages/Henry Ford/Recipes/Search Results

Display:

- Return to Search uses return to search link set in recipe listings properties. Default returns to Recipe Search landing page. This label can be changed in Sitecore.
- If a category has been selected for search, the category label in the proximity navigation will remain bold on the search results page
- Headline page headline is Recipe Search Results
- Photo display photo field reduced to smaller size, consistent sizing for images, crops off top portion when applicable
- Recipe name overlays on image, pulls from recipe detail Headline field. Content will be cut
 off at a predetermined character limit and followed by an ellipses. Character limit is
 configurable in Sitecore.
- Entire image is the link. Mouse over shows underline hover state for text.
- Display pagination control, same as on default module styling (see News module)
- Number to display is set in the component properties
- Recipe logos, e.g. Heart Smart logo, will appear in the top right corner of the image.

Result sort order:

- Ranking when searching by keyword. The search engine uses Lucene, which gives pages a score based on the words that are searched on. The score is based on multiple factors.
 Higher scores appear first. Matching scores are displayed in random order.
- Alphabetical A-Z by recipe name when searching all, by category, by ingredient, or browsing by category (keyword is not entered)

Ingredients	Tree list to tag uses Ingredient Global Source List /sitecore/content/Global/Recipes/Recipes Ingredients A Global popup can be accessed from Ingredients field using the Add Item link. New Global items need to be published in addition to Recipe pages. Using the Global Source List allows the same ingredients to be added to multiple Recipes in Content, and allows ingredients to be searched.
Logo	Image. Displays a logo image above the recipe image. Ex. Heart Smart logo in design. Logos are added in the Recipe Data section of Recipe Content.
Featured Recipe Slide Photo	Featured image will automatically display the recipe image. Optional only needs to be used if overwriting the recipe image.
Featured	Not used, recipe slider is not implemented for HFHS

Display

- Return to Search returns to previous search result

- Yield: display Yield field
- Nutritional Information display nutritional information field

Related Recipe Component

- Component to place on pages through Presentation Details: Shared Layout > Edit > Controls
 > Add: Renderings/Henry Ford/Modules/Recipes/Related Recipes
- Default places on all recipe detail pages



Related Recipes when placed on a page:

- Tagging takes place in the tagging section of a recipe in Sitecore content. If there is no tagging on the page, shows all recipes
- If a recipe page has tagging, other recipes with matching tagging will populate related recipes. Tagging follows AND logic between distinct tagging fields & OR logic within the same tagging field.
- Tagging structure is the default used for base modules.
- Matched items are listed alphabetically A-Z.
- Displays 3 related recipes. For recipes with more than 3 recipes with matching tagging, top 3 recipes are chosen by alpha order.
