

Afterhours Personalization Training

Overview

MedTouch created 2 unique custom date and time rules, which enables the HFHS organization to "personalize" components on their pages for campaigns like afterhours care options for patients. Leveraging these rules will allow HFHS to promote walk-in clinics and urgent cares outside of non-business hours, weekends, and holidays to visitors on the website.


Creating Designated Days

Before beginning, determine the specific calendar days and the timeframes on those days that you would like to set up rules for.

Note – Not ALL days/times for an entire year need to be finalized at once. You can ADD to this at any


point throughout the year

With dates and time in hand, navigate to the Global section of the site and location the **Condition Rendering** folder (sitecore/Content/Global/Conditional Rendering).






Dates will be created in subfolders under HFHS. To begin, right-click on the HFHS item and insert a **Conditional Dates Folder.**




Use a name that is recognizable and unique enough when you need to associate it to a component later on.






You can begin to create individual dates by right-clicking on your newly created folder to insert a **Conditional Date.**

Note – You can have as many date(s) as you would like in a folder (e.g. 1 date, 20 dates, etc)




Use a unique, recognizable name for the date name.






A Conditional Date is comprised of the following

- 1. **Description (in red)** Where an optional description can be added in the single-line text field
 - a. By default will pull in the item name but can be changed to anything
- 2. Start (in blue) Where the Start Date and Time will be indicated using the date and time pickers
 - a. By default will be empty
 - b. Time can be inputted in Eastern Standard Time (no need to convert)
 - c. The start day and time must be BEFORE the end date and time
- 3. End (in green) Where the End Date and Time will be indicated using the date and time pickers
 - a. By default will be empty
 - b. Time can be inputted in Eastern Standard Time (no need to convert)
 - c. The End date and time must be AFTER the start end and time
 - i. The End date and time can be on the same day
 - ii. The End date and time can span multiple days as needed (see Sample screenshot)



Once all the date(s) under the folder have been created, publish your newly created items.





Updating Component


Before beginning:

- 1. Determine the components you would like to leverage these rules with
 - a. In this example, we will be targeting the Hero Banner control used on the Homepage and HF Landing pages
- 2. Create the alternative content for your components
 - a. In this example, we will be showing pre-created hero banner content

Note – Not all components on the page are 'personalizable'. If you have any questions about which ones are and which ones are not, reference personalization training documents or reach out to MedTouch to help answer your questions!


To begin:

- 1. Navigate to the desired page
- 2. Under Presentation
- 3. Click on the **Details** icon






Under **Shared Layouts**, click the **Edit** link at the end of the list of components.






Under **Controls**, highlight the component you would like to personalization (**Hero Banners** are used in this example). Click the **Personalize** button in the right hand side of the dialog.






This will open the personalized component dialog where you will indicate your content and create the conditions that will be checked when determining what version of content to render.

Set the **Default** content first. This content will render if all other conditions/rules indicated are not met. To begin, click on the box shown in the screenshot.






This will open a dialog. Navigate to your designated content. In this example, we will be selecting the from the global hero banners section. Since this is the hero banners control, where multiple hero banners can render, we have to select the folder.






With the default content indicated, create your first condition by clicking the **New Condition** button in the upper right corner.



Name your condition uniquely. Once named, click on the **Edit** button to begin to add rules for this condition.






In the Rules Set Editor dialog that opens, find the **Custom Date and Time** type rules.

Rule 1: Where the current date and time is between start day start time and end day end time

- This rule will check if the current date and time is between the start and enddate/times indicated
- You will be able to indicate general days of the week
- Both days and times are required in this rule
 - NOTE: Times entered are based on the SC server time, not local machine time.
- Use Rule 2 instead if you need to indicate exact calendar date(s)


Rule 2: Where the current dates and times are conditional dates folder

- This rule will be used in conjunction with the specific dates created in global
- You will point to the appropriate conditional dates folder
- This rule will compare the current date and time with the exact dates/times in the folder






Click on the Rule 1 to add to the listing. To being to build Rule 1 out, click on the Start Day.






The dialog of days of the week will open. Select the appropriate day.






Clicking **Start Time** will open the dialog where you can enter the start time on the designated day. While the time entry is flexible, we recommend using the following standard time format: **HH: MM**. Examples:



Note – If incorrect characters are mistakenly used (e.g. entering a semicolon rather than a colon), the control will not render on the page.




Using the same steps, indicate the **End Day** and the **End Time**.






Continue adding the additional days of the week as needed.






To ensure that any of the rules would trigger the condition, click on the **AND** for the newly added rule to change the logic operator to an **OR**.




Indicate the start/end days and times for the newly added rule.






The end date does not need to be on the same day. In this example we have extended the time frame into the next day. As long as the current date and time falls within the timeframe, the rule with trigger and render the indicated content.






Rule 2 can also be leveraged within the same condition or in a separate condition if content will differ. Click on the rule to add to the list of condition(s).




Click on the Condition Dates Folder.






Select the conditional dates folder created in global.






Once all rules have been added, click **OK** to save changes.






After indicating the rules, indicate the content that should render if this condition is TRUE.




Continue adding conditions according to content options as needed.

Note – Any number of conditions can be added if content needs dictate.






Once all condition(s) are in place, you can reorder the conditions. The conditions will be checked according to the order listed here.






Once all conditions and the proper order has been finalized, click **OK** to confirm and save.






Exceptions – These rules can also be altered to indicate an **exception**. Click on **where** to change to an **except where** rule.




In the example noted below, if the current date and time is NOT within the timeframe, the rule will be considered TRUE.






Leveraging Additional Rules – These 2 rules can be coupled with OTHER rules and other actively running campaigns.

In the example noted below, the GeoIP Address match will first be checked if true.






Once all conditions for the component have been updated, click **OK** to confirm all changes.






Save and publish your changes.





Example – Condition 1 Match




Dates/Times for Condition 1:

Example – Condition 2 Match




Dates/Times for Condition 2:

- Holidays/Dates under /sitecore/content/Global/Conditional Rendering/HFHS/Test Condition 2
- Mondays 12noon Monday 1pm EST
- Mondays 4pm Monday 9pm EST
- Tuesdays 5pm Wednesdays 1am EST
- Thursdays 5pm 9pm EST
- Fridays 5pm Saturdays 12:59am EST
- Saturdays 8am 8pm EST
- Sundays 11am 4pm EST

If conditions 1 and 2 have not been met, then the default hero banner(s) will render
